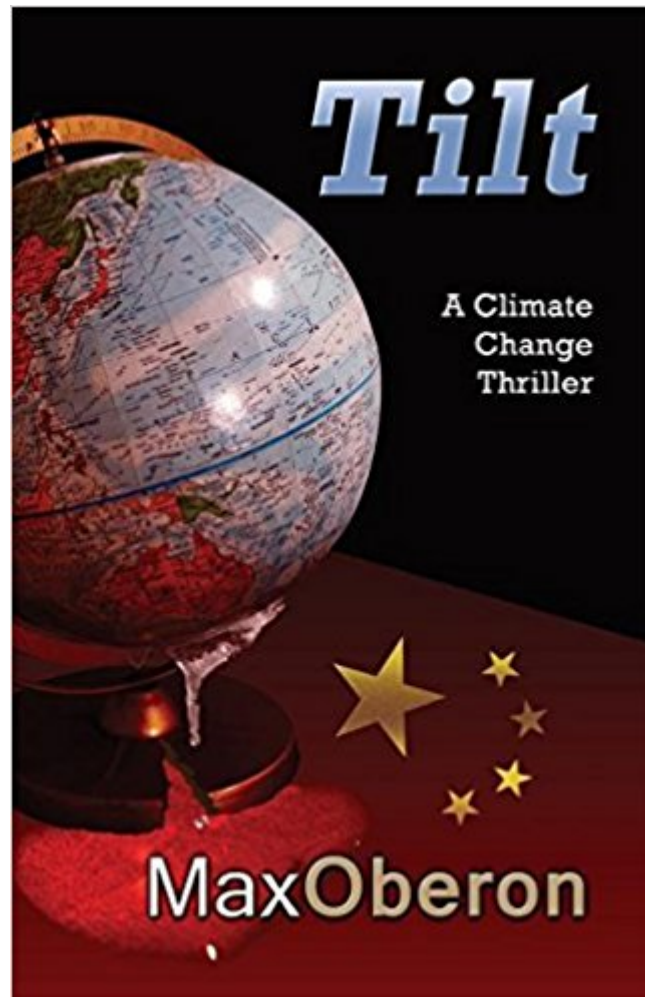


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TILT A Climate Change Ecothriller Conspiracy About Mining In Antarctica

TILT is a fast moving novel which covers world espionage, sex, spying and romance across the USA, China, Hong Kong, Australia and Malaysia. It is an exciting suspense filled page-turner that gets better as the plot develops towards what may be a plausible explanations â for conspiracy theorists at least- of contemporary history events such as the disappearance of the Malaysia Airlines Flight MH370 in 2014 and lack of significant debris, the recent crash in iron ore prices, greenhouse gas emissions and China's inconsistent environmental approach to some resource developments. *TILT* evokes comparisons with thrillers such as those of John Grisham. Woven into the plot are other major events such as the Air New Zealand Flight 901 crash in 1979, gas exploration in Australia, the 2015 United Nations Climate Change Conference in Paris, the building of the environmental and culturally controversial Three Gorges Dam in China and US / China

relationships. I cannot wait to see a potential movie sequel !

Very intriguing novel that is more than just a book on climate change. In 1979 Senator Tom Bradley and his wife died when their plane crashed in Antarctica. Their son Jack was devastated and thirty years later finds himself back in the same area where his parents died, although he doesn't have a clue as to what has been going on the last thirty years and what the conspiracy means for the planet and for him and his new friend Shirley. The author did a great job tying all the loose ends together and making this suspenseful conspiracy thriller one for readers to grab.

I found Tilt to be an intriguing and intelligent novel that benefits from a solid plot and a top notch narrative. I've read a few novels with similar themes but Tilt is one of the best I have read. It works so well because the author demonstrates a clear understanding of the issues the world is facing in respect of climate change and by weaving international conspiracy on a grand scale creates a highly believable scenario.

Tilt: A Climate Change Thriller is a fast paced read with an interesting hypothesis as to the cause of climate change. An intriguing story that links historical events with the story line that really adds interest. Plenty of action, an interesting cast of characters and a bit racey romantic action make for an enjoyable read.

I call this type of book semi-fiction. It's packed with interesting facts that I was previously unaware of about the mining industry. A little like John Grisham and his lawyer themes. Has the Author observed for himself these gigantic ore ships at work? His bio indicates a naval history. After reading this book I am more concerned than ever of the possible consequences of mining and transporting materials from one hemisphere to another in such massive quantities.
